



# Bringing Best Practices to Housing Redevelopment to Promote Health

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In partnership with existing coalitions and the Urban Institute, the VCU Center on Society and Health will convene a Redevelopment Public Health Team comprised of residents, local service providers and other stakeholders poised to affect services delivered to local residents. The team will meet monthly to identify and prioritize health needs in the community, review recommendations for evidence-based practices from the Urban Institute, and make recommendations for coordinated services.

**Main Objective:** to promote the health of East End residents throughout the proposed housing redevelopment process.
